For consumers on notified prices, the additional increase will not be backdated; however, the increase does affect the notified prices for 2009–10

⁷ the overall increase from the original 2008-09 notified prices (based on 5.38% increase) to what consumers on notified prices will pay from 1 July 2009 will be approximately 15.67%
